- **Use the suggested log sheet on page 7 of the plan to record:**
 - **Any decisions you have made**
 - **Who you spoke to and what you said**
- **Contact other members of the Community that need to be alerted:**
 - **Those specifically under threat**
 - **The local Council via the Clerk**
 - **Volunteers and key holders that may be needed**

Contact initially may be to inform them of the emergency or inform them of current Emergency Service regarding any action to be taken.

Community Emergency Meeting

A Community Emergency meeting may be called if a severe weather warning has been issued or there has been a specific incident requiring attention. Such a meeting would be held in the Village Hall or Church as appropriate; residents would be notified if time allowed, notification of such a meeting would be displayed on the Parish Council notice board.
