- 1. Rev David Baldwin (Rector) welcomed everyone and opened with prayer.

- 5. Financial Report: report submitted at the last PCC meeting which was approved and accepted then. MB produced an update of latest figures. Proposed DW; seconded KM.

- 8. The Clergy Report: Rector was addressing the problems of understaffing in the benefice. He highlighted that in the 1960s there were 8 Priests in Charge, and 6 Vicars. As late as 1973 Melplash and Mapperton had their own Vicars. He stated that today's structure cannot be upheld, worsened by 3 churches having no Churchwardens, and 1 church having no PCC. In 1994 the Rector had 2 Team Vicars and 7 Retired Priests.

Attendances: only 8am Holy Communion at Beaminster had seen an increase in size of congregation at normal' services. But Messy Church was the best attended, recent service had 90 attending with 43 children. Broadwindsor After School Club was also encouraging with 18-24 children and usually 12 parents attending. Other growth spots were: Tea Church at Broadwindsor (usually 23); Coffee,

Chat and Worship at the 10.15 Solway Ash service, and approximately 250 children joined in with the Holiday Clubs.

The Rector expressed his gratitude to JS as Churchwarden; MB as Treasurer, especially the worth of his detailed reports; KM for bearing such a burden with the building problems; DW & TB for attending deanery Synod and Team Council; DE for minutes and agendas.
