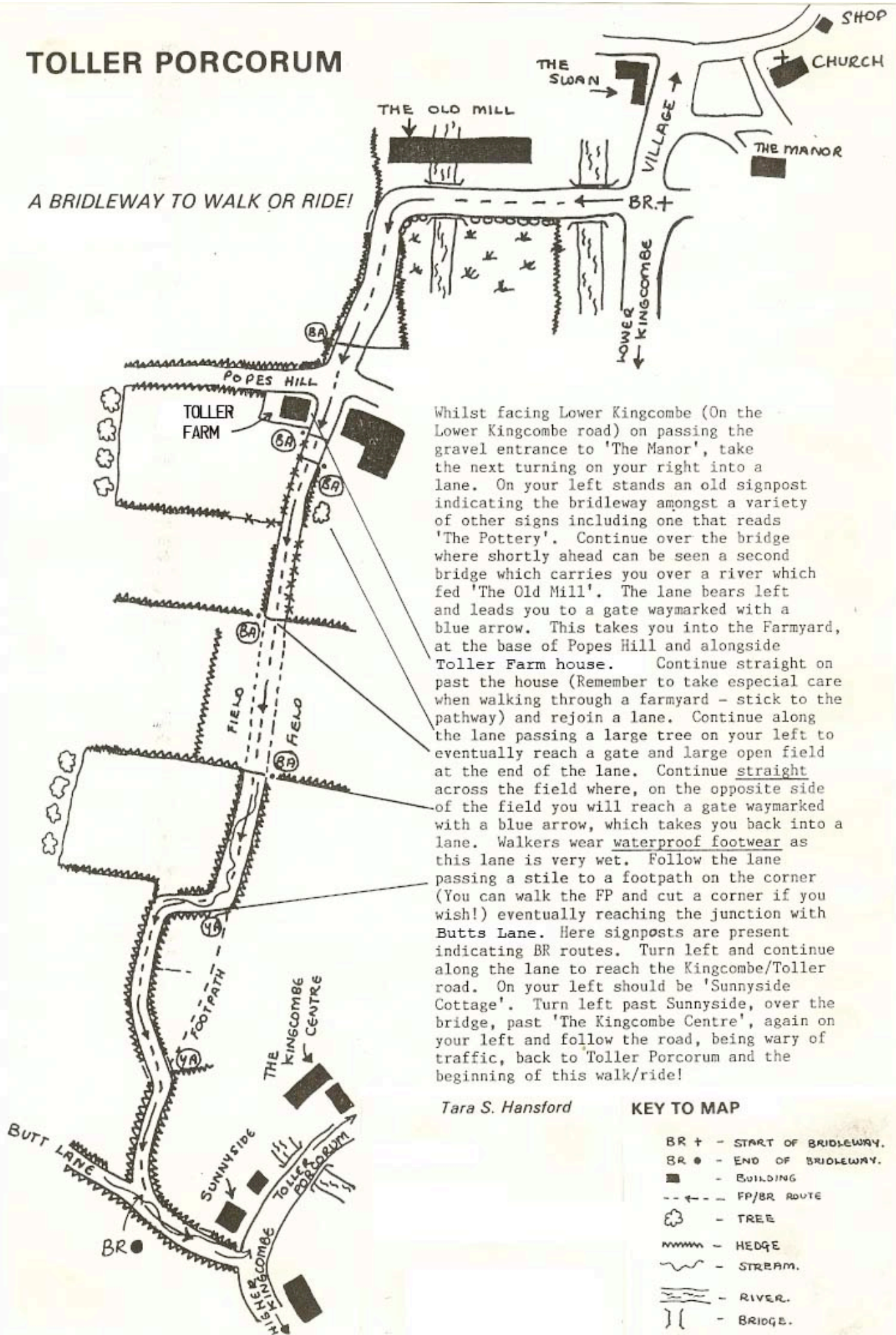


TOLLER PORCORUM

A BRIDLEWAY TO WALK OR RIDE!



Whilst facing Lower Kingcombe (On the Lower Kingcombe road) on passing the gravel entrance to 'The Manor', take the next turning on your right into a lane. On your left stands an old signpost indicating the bridleway amongst a variety of other signs including one that reads 'The Pottery'. Continue over the bridge where shortly ahead can be seen a second bridge which carries you over a river which fed 'The Old Mill'. The lane bears left and leads you to a gate waymarked with a blue arrow. This takes you into the Farmyard, at the base of Popes Hill and alongside Toller Farm house. Continue straight on past the house (Remember to take especial care when walking through a farmyard - stick to the pathway) and rejoin a lane. Continue along the lane passing a large tree on your left to eventually reach a gate and large open field at the end of the lane. Continue straight across the field where, on the opposite side of the field you will reach a gate waymarked with a blue arrow, which takes you back into a lane. Walkers wear waterproof footwear as this lane is very wet. Follow the lane passing a stile to a footpath on the corner (You can walk the FP and cut a corner if you wish!) eventually reaching the junction with Butts Lane. Here signposts are present indicating BR routes. Turn left and continue along the lane to reach the Kingcombe/Toller road. On your left should be 'Sunnyside Cottage'. Turn left past Sunnyside, over the bridge, past 'The Kingcombe Centre', again on your left and follow the road, being wary of traffic, back to Toller Porcorum and the beginning of this walk/ride!
